#### Curate's Corner - Rev Coryn Stanforth

One of my earliest memories is being taken to Norwich Airport by my mum. It felt like a very long walk from home for a small child. When we arrived, we did not enter the airport but joined a large crowd on the pavement of the road leading into the airport. I was clutching my Union Flag tightly in my hand. There was a sense of anticipation and excitement. Eventually, a large car appeared further up the road. The gathered crowd began to cheer. I finally got to wave my flag. As the car drove



past us, I got a glimpse of Queen Elizabeth II. The Queen was celebrating twenty-five years on the throne. In July 1977 she had arrived in Norwich as part of her Silver Jubilee celebrations.

This month another momentous celebration will be taking place, that of her Platinum Jubilee. She will be the first British monarch to celebrate seventy years of service. Seventy years as monarch is an amazing achievement. As the Queen's reign has progressed, she has become more open about the strong Christian faith which is the foundation of her life.

The monarch is the Supreme Governor of the Church of England as the established Church. She can be seen on television attending public worship at Christmas and Easter as well as usually distributing the Maundy money and attending the Remembrance Sunday service at the Cenotaph.

We get the biggest glimpse of her faith in her Christmas messages. Unlike the Queen's speech in Parliament, her Christmas message is not regulated by the government. In her 2017 message to the nation the Queen said:

"Billions of people now follow Christ's teaching and find in Him the guiding light for their lives. I am one of them because Christ's example helps me see the value of doing small things with great love, whoever does them and whatever they themselves believe."

The Queen's openness about her faith, as well as her motivation to serve the country offer an example to all.

There are lots of celebratory events planned for the long Jubilee weekend of  $2^{nd}$ -  $5^{th}$  June. Please have a look at what is being held and join in the celebrations.

#### Jobs In The Garden This Month - Royal Horticultural Society June 21st is the longest day of the year, and the extra light and

warmth encourages the garden to put on an exuberant burst of growth. But this extra light and warmth also means weeds will sprout up from seemingly nowhere. Keep on top of them by hoeing regularly in dry conditions. Other jobs to be doing this month:

- 1. Position summer hanging baskets and containers outside
- 2. Be water-wise, especially in drought-affected areas
- 3. Pinch out side shoots on tomatoes
- 4. Harvest lettuce, radish, other salads and early potatoes
- 5. Hoe borders regularly to keep down weeds
- 6. Mow lawns at least once a week but consider leaving some areas uncut for wildlife
- 7. Plant out summer bedding
- 8. Stake tall or floppy plants
- 9. Prune many spring-flowering shrubs
- 10. Shade greenhouses to keep them cool and prevent scorch
