Curate's Corner - Rev. Coryn Stanforth

I have been reflecting about the last few weeks and wanted to share something with you about my recent pilgrimage to the Holy Land. The Bishop of Norwich led a group of curates, together with friends and family members, to the Holy Land in March. The first part of the visit was based in Tiberias. We took a boat out into the Lake of Galilee where we said Morning Prayer, whilst looking at the lake and hills which would have been so familiar to Jesus. Later that day, we gathered on the beach where the risen Jesus prepared breakfast for his disciples.



After three nights in Tiberias, we moved to Jesus' birthplace, Bethlehem. We visited the site of the stable where Jesus was born, now in the Church of the Nativity and also the Shepherd's Fields. A far more challenging visit was to the Aida Palestinian Refugee Camp. Aida Camp is situated in the shadow of the security wall separating the West Bank from Israel. The camp has existed for seventy years. We heard the painful stories of some of the residents about having no real home.

On Passion Sunday, exactly two weeks before Easter Day we travelled up to Jerusalem. On the journey, I thought about how Jesus had travelled to Jerusalem as the time of his trial and crucifixion drew near. We joined local Christians worshipping at St George's Anglican Cathedral before an afternoon visit to the Holocaust Memorial. The Holocaust Memorial is another difficult visit. You engage with the horrific stories of those murdered during the Holocaust and the necessity of a safe place to call home. The visits to Aida Camp and the Holocaust Memorial were both challenging and laid bare the raw pain on both sides of the conflict in the Holy Land.

The time in Jerusalem also offered so many opportunities to walk in the footsteps of Jesus including the Garden of Gethsemane where he was arrested. The garden is full of ancient, gnarled olive trees. We walked the Via Dolorosa, the way of the cross, through the Old City. The route ended at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre; this church contains the sites of both Jesus' crucifixion and resurrection.

I felt very privileged to participate in the pilgrimage and was back just in time to join in with the events of Holy Week and Easter in the Tas Valley. What a blessing those services were, particularly the joyful Easter Day services in both Newton Flotman and Swainsthorpe.

Cervical screening awareness week 19th – 24th June 2023

In a previous issue, I spoke about the importance of cervical screening in women. In June, a week is specially dedicated to cervical screening awareness, and I felt I had to add something on this topic again. In January this year, NHS England published a news article on their website on this topic and the introductory paragraph was quite scary! It read "The NHS has issued a call for anyone eligible for cervical screening to come forward for a potentially life-saving appointment, with nearly a third, around 4.6 million, not taking up their latest test. The plea from senior NHS medics comes on the back of the health service sending a record number of invites for cervical screening in the last year, as part of its ambition to eradicate the cancer through a combination of vaccination and early identification.'

Once again, a reminder about cervical screening. Cervical screening is offered to all women and people with a cervix between the ages of 25 and 64. A letter is sent from NHS England inviting you to make an appointment. If patients do not attend their screening their GP surgery is informed, as a safety net, we take over their care and send a further invitation.

Based on our current searches these are the numbers of our patients that are currently overdue their cervical screening:

Patients aged 25 to 34 = 135Patients aged 35 to 49 = 223Patients aged 50 to 65 = 291

354 of patients are currently HPV positive and have not responded to follow up requests

I encourage you to take up this screening if you are eligible, raise awareness in your family and friends circle and help in the eradication of this cancer.

My Wildlife Back Garden

Just when I thought I was looking at a pale grey stone it started to move slowly; I was in fact seeing a Holly Blue Butterfly drinking water from the pond edge. For many people the Holly Blue is a familiar species as it is often found in gardens where holly and ivy the two plants it is most closely associated with - are common. Both sexes have blue upper wings although they are paler in females. Its dark wing margins are more exclusive in females and more so in the second brood of the year. The pale bluish white



underwings of both sexes are adorned with small black spots. Found in diverse habitats such as woodland, inland cliffs and gardens, the common factor being the availability of larval food plants Larval food plant mainly Holly (*llex*) for the first brood larvae but lvy (*Hedra*) for the second brood larvae.

The dead hedge on the corner of 1 Clabburn Close has been laid by my tree surgeons (not dumped). The dead hedge will have stakes added to keep it in place once the hazel has been coppiced. Please remember that this area gets managed less frequently for the Hedgehogs and the biodiversity food chain.
